

## General Instructions

1. Candidate must carry his / her school I-Card along with him/her to the centre.
2. No Candidate without Admit Card shall be allowed to sit in the examination by the Centre Superintendent.
3. No Candidate in any case will be allowed to enter at the Examination Centre after the commencement of the examination.
4. No candidate shall be allowed to leave the Examination Hall before the conclusion of the test and without handing over the Answer Sheet to the Invigilator concerned.
5. Candidates should check and ensure that the Test Booklet contains as many number of pages as written on the top of the cover page.
6. Candidate shall not remove any page(s) from the Test booklet.
7. Candidates should bring good quality blue/black ball point pens or pencils for the examination.
8. Candidates should use blue/black ball point pen or pencil to write particulars on the cover page of Test Booklet, OMR Sheet and for darkening the circles of response.
9. Calculators, Log tables, Calculating devices, Communication Devices like Cellular Phone./Pager etc. And Textual materials are not allowed in the Exam Hall.
10. If a candidate is found in possession of Celullar Phone/Paper/Document during the exam, the same will be fortelled and his/her candidature will be cancelled.
11. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as contained in the information Bulletin.
12. All the questions are compulsory.
13. For class NURSERY to I Question paper consists of 45 questions & each question carry one mark.
14. For class II to V Question paper consists of 75 questions & each question carry one mark.
15. For Class VI to IX Question paper consists of 100 questions & each question carry one mark.
16. On this Multiple-choice Test each question or item is followed by series of possible answers or choices,
17. Read each question and decide which answer or choice is correct. (Make sure you read thoroughly any special instructions that may apply to a given portion of the test).
18. ERASE completely any answers you wish to change. Do not cross out.
19. Mark only ONE answer for EACH question. Double answers are scored as wrong answers.
20. Keep your OMR ANSWER SHEET on a hard surface while marking your answers. Do not fold or crease your OMR Answer sheet.
21. Try to answer every question. Your best score will be based on the number of questions you answer correctly.
22. There will be negative marking of one fourth of each wrong question.
23. On completion of the test candidate must handover the Test Booklet to the invigilator in the room/hall.
